

Notice of Election on Tax Levy in Excess of the Ten Mill Limitation

R.C. 3501.11(G), 5705.19, 5705.25

Notice is hereby given that in pursuance of a Resolution of the NEWBURY TOWNSHIP, Ohio, passed on the July 21, 2021, there will be submitted to a vote of the people at the GENERAL ELECTION to be held at the regular places of voting on Tuesday, the 2th day of November, 2021 the question of levying a tax, in excess of the ten mill limitation:

A renewal of a tax for the benefit of Newbury Township for the purpose of general construction, reconstruction, resurfacing, and repair of streets, roads, and bridges at a rate not exceeding 1.9 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to \$0.19 for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for a continuing period of time, commencing in 2022, first due in calendar year 2023.

The polls for the election will be open 6:30 a.m. and remain open until 7:30 p.m. on election day.
